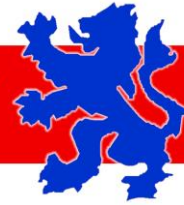

Under 8s and Under 10s – Stick 2 Hockey – new season starts end of April

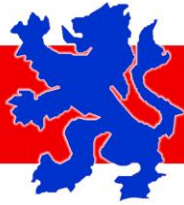

With the recent cultural issues of the Australian Men's Cricket Team it is an important reminder that playing sport is not just about having a culture of winning but more importantly one where players show respect.

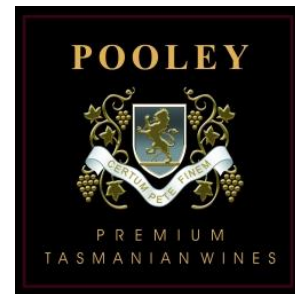
Players (including coaches, parents and supporters) must always treat their fellow players, coaching staff, umpires, officials, opposing players and their supporters with respect, courtesy, and consideration and play within the rules. This means avoiding and preventing put-downs, name calling, insults, or other verbal or non-verbal conduct towards others.

If you think an umpire misunderstands a rule or made a wrong decision, you should not humiliate the umpire through your own behaviour.

It should be emphasised that demeaning, ridiculing, yelling at, swearing or embarrassing players, coaches, umpires, officials and supporters for any reason including their mistakes will not be tolerated.

Treat everyone as you would like to be treated, recognising and appreciating their diversity in gender, ethnicity, skills and capability as a part of good sportsmanship and respectful behaviour.

If all Canterbury players, coaches, parents and supporters follow the above we will end up with **Respectful Players**, creating **Respectful Teams**, enabling Canterbury to be a **Respectful Club** and ultimately being **Successful** in everything we do.

2018 Mens Captains

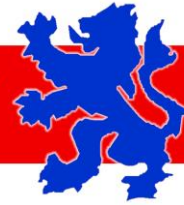


Sam McCulloch and Simon O'Connor were recently named as joint captains of the Mens Premier League team. Congrats to both and all the best for a successful 2018 season.
